SCoPE seminars in a nutshell

- Monthly (almost) asynchronous discussions and other learning activities
- · Facilitated by volunteers, ranging from novice to expert
- Free and open to the public, no registration required
- No obligations to 'actively' participate

Design considerations

- Participation on the periphery
- Attention to history
- Rhythm and variety, build anticipation
- Focus on people and dialogue, not content
- Focus on structure, not what to 'cover'
- Ideas for activities emerge through participation
- Mutual exchange of services / collaboration
- Different modes and levels of engagement

- Design for the unknown?
- New possibilities
- Emerging and multiple facilitators
- New formats
- Less control
- More flexible
- Selective attention
