Key Features of Critical Race Theory

- 1.Racism is Everywhere We need to go beyond debating if it exists and focus attention on understanding how it is embedded into the structures of our institutions and to seek alternatives.
- 2 Question Neutrality, Colour-Blindness, and Meritocracy Anytime we hear there is a single truth or that there are equal opportunities we should dig deeper. Who created and benefits from this narrative? Who has access to power?
- 3. Understand Context We did not just wake up to a racist world, there has been a lot of time, effort and resource put into the systems and structures. Examining historical reading of institutional policies and practices can inform about how we got here.
- 4. Value Experiential Knowledge Often times the world does not recognize the lived experience of racism. Counter narratives are shared from the vantage point of people who experience marginalization.
- 5. Critically Examine Power Critical Race Theory is interdisciplinary in the ways it interrogates power and aims to create a more racially just future.
- 6. Race is at the Centre When considering intersectionality Critical Race Theory posits that race is at the centre of the ways that systems of oppression overlap and intersect.
