


#### Some terms?!?

- Generative AI (GenAI) deep learning models that can generate high-quality text, images, and other content based on the data they were trained on.
- Large Language Models (LLMs) AI systems capable of understanding and generating human language by processing vast amounts of text data (Chat Bot))(e.g. ChatGPT, Claude, Gemini, Meta)
- A Custom Bot a version of an LLM chatbot that has been given specific instructions and set up on a platform that can be shared with others via a link


