Spectrum Label	Description	Criteria / Self-Assessment Prompts
 <b>GenAI-Averse</b>	I am highly skeptical, concerned, or opposed to AI use in education.	<p>“I worry about ethical, societal, or pedagogical harm.”</p> <p>“I’m unsure AI has a place in good teaching.”</p> <p>“I’m here to voice my concerns.”</p>
 <b>Cautious Skeptic</b>	I’ve tried or explored GenAI, but I remain critical and selective in how (or if) I use it.	<p>“I have mixed feelings.”</p> <p>“I see both risks and rewards.”</p> <p>“I’m curious, but protecting core pedagogical values.”</p>
 <b>Curious Newbie</b>	I’m new to GenAI and excited (or nervous) to learn more.	<p>“I’ve heard about it, but haven’t used it.”</p> <p>“I want to learn how it might help my teaching.”</p>
 <b>Pragmatic Tinkerer</b>	I’ve experimented with GenAI tools and am exploring use in teaching.	<p>“I’ve tested some tools.”</p> <p>“I’m looking for ways to integrate GenAI responsibly and practically.”</p>
 <b>Confident Explorer</b>	I’ve integrated GenAI into my practice and want to go deeper.	<p>“I’ve used GenAI in assignments or planning.”</p> <p>“I’m exploring ethical and creative use.”</p>
 <b>Transformative Designer</b>	I’m rethinking my teaching, assessment, or curriculum with GenAI in mind.	<p>“I’m designing AI-aware syllabi or assessments.”</p> <p>“I’m helping others understand GenAI.”</p> <p>“I’m embracing transformation.”</p>
 <b>Critical Ethicist</b>	My focus is on ethical literacy, academic integrity, and responsible AI advocacy.	<p>“I engage deeply with the ethical and equity implications.”</p> <p>“I want AI to enhance—not replace—human learning.”</p>
